### **EXERCISE TO MANAGE WATER SHORTAGE IN HIGH LYING AREAS**

In dealing with water shortage in higher lying areas of Flora Park and Serala View, Polokwane Municipality implements water supply management operation that will help in pushing supply to those areas. The exercise is to ensure that high lying areas do not continue to experience continuous shortage impact of water as it has been the case over a longer period.

The municipality believes this exercise will bring relief to the affected areas and will be implement weekly as follows, starting from today:

**Days:** Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays

**Time:** 16h00 to 04h00

The exercise was trialed in the past days through management of water systems on the line supplying to the CBD - and this has yielded positive results.


The municipality appeals for cooperation of users in the CBD, Nirvana and Ivy Park as this exercise will limit flow of water to their areas on the scheduled days; and further appreciates cooperation and understanding of all during this difficult period of water scarcity.

Regular updates will be provided in terms of the impact of the exercise.


Polokwane Municipality urges all to continue using water sparingly.
