NO WATER SUPPLY FROM LEPELLE NORTHERN WATER

Polokwane Municipality's reservoir levels would take longer to recover as Lepelle Northern Water is experiencing challenges from both its water schemes, Ebenezer and Olifantspoort.

In a report sent to the municipality last night, Lepelle Northern Water said they were still not pumping water from the Ebenezer line to Polokwane due electrical challenges experienced in that area. The area has been experiencing electrical outages caused by fallen electric poles among others, since early hours of yesterday.

Lepelle Northern Water, in another report this morning, alerts the municipality of a challenge experienced on Olifantspoort line. The water utility says it is currently running at low capacity due to muddy raw water from Mhlaletse River. Pump stations 2 and 3 have also experienced stoppages this morning.


These challenges, from both Ebenezer and Olifantspoort, are affecting water supply to all areas of supply within Polokwane Municipality.


The municipality will provide regular updates in terms of any progress in addressing these challenges.
