### **PLANNED DISRUPTION OF WATER SUPPLY TO POLOKWANE**

Polokwane Municipality has been notified by Lepelle Northern Water of a planned electricity supply shutdown "by Greater Tzaneen Municipality which will affect operations at Ebenezer Plant" as follows:

**Date:** Sunday, 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2021

**Time:** 06h00 – 18h00

Lepelle Northern Water (LNW), in a letter addressed to the municipality, said "the plant will not be operational during the shutdown period, thus there will be a disruption in water supply" to Polokwane Municipality.

The water utility had also planned to disrupt water supply to Polokwane Municipality on Thursday, 20<sup>th</sup> May 2021 due to a reported leak and illegal connections discovered along the main line towards Boyne. However, Thursday's planned disruption has been put on hold until further notice.

Sunday's shutdown will affect all supply areas from Segwashi, Boyne, Mentz and Mankweng to City and Seshego.

Polokwane Municipality apologizes for the inconvenience that the shutdown may cause.
