PLANNED PIPELINE REPAIRS AND WATER SUPPLY SHUTDOWN

Residents and businesses, within Polokwane Municipality's City Cluster, are hereby notified of a planned water supply shutdown on Tuesday, 08 December 2020 between 08h00 and 18h00. The supply shutdown is necessary for municipal water team to conduct repairs on a 550mm pipe on corner of Hans van Rensburg and Devenish streets.

This, therefore, will affect water supply to areas along Devenish, Westenburg, Nirvana, Extensions 40 and 44 with high expectation of low pressure from the line. Temporary relief measure in a form of water tankers will be provided.

Road users, in particular motorists, are urged to avoid Hans van Rensburg and Devenish intersection and use alternative routes on that day as there will be excavation work in the middle of the road.

On the day of the supply shutdown, the municipality will provide regular updates on the municipal communication platforms and through traditional media channels in terms of progress on this issue.

Areas receiving supply are urged to use water sparingly.

All water and sanitation related challenges, including water shortage, leaks and burst pipes, can be reported to water and sanitation call centre at 015 023 5376 / 015 023 5629.
