### **RESERVOIR LEVELS AFFECTED BY OLIFANTS STOPPAGE**

Reservoir or storage dams levels have been negatively affected by yesterday's stoppage of Olifantspoort plant by Lepelle Northern Water due to multiple leaks on the Specon pipe line to Polokwane. Both the Olifants and Ebenezer plants are currently in operation.

As of this morning before 06h00, the Potgieter reservoir level is at 0%, whilst the main reservoir at Krugersburg is at 5% and two others at 0%. The Seshego reservoir is at 5%. This is a serious setback to progress that was being made to restore the reservoir levels. The municipality and Lepelle Northern Water will work together on the situation.

#### **Mankweng area pipe burst being attended**

In the meantime, the municipality is attending to a pipe burst in the Makweng area from the GaThoka reservoir next to Paledi Mall. According to the notice, it would take approximately six hours to repair the line. The Mankweng and surrounding areas will be affected.

Areas receiving water are urged to continue using water withuse water sparingly.


The municipality will continue to provide relief to affected areas through water tankers.
