UPDATE ON RESERVOIR LEVELS

Water tankers will continue to provide temporary relief to areas affected by water shortage caused by low reservoir levels. Reservoir levels within Polokwane Municipality have shown no improvement since Wednesday.

Lepelle Northern Water had experienced multiple challenges from Olifantspoort line resulting in a more than 24 hour stoppage of the plant while Ebenezer was experiencing power failure causing supply shortage to Polokwane. LNW has, yesterday, completed repairs but warned that it will still take some time for water supply to reach all affected areas.

As of this morning, Potgieter, Seshego, Krugersburg Dome and Flat are all sitting at 0% while Ivydale is at 5%.

Polokwane Municipality urges areas receiving supply to use water sparingly in an effort to improve reservoir levels for all to receive water.
