### **UPDATE ON SUPPLY CHALLENGE FROM EBENEZER**

Reservoir levels in Polokwane have not shown any improvement as a result of challenges experienced by Lepelle Northern Water's Ebenezer Plant.

The Ebenezer Plant has been experiencing continuous power outages as a result of storms and winds over the weekend. The plant was stopped again yesterday to allow for repairs in Mentz village on a pipeline supplying to Polokwane Municipality. Lepelle Northern Water team had initially estimated five hours from 09h00 yesterday for completion of repairs. However, an update was received this morning that repairs had just been completed.

This morning's reservoir levels are still strained:

- Potgieter – 0%
- Krugersburg 50MI – 0%
- Krugersburg 30MI – 0%
- Krugersburg 30MI – 0%


The challenge on the Ebenezer line has affected Segwashi, Boyne, Badimong, Mankweng, Sebayeng, Ga-Dikgale, Segopye, Ga-Mothapo, Makotopong, Lastehoop, Dalmada and City. It will still take some time for supply to reach all affected areas because the pipeline was empty.

Areas receiving supply are urged to use water sparingly.
