RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide independent oversight, leadership, and strategic direction to the Risk Management Committee in fulfilling its governance and oversight mandate.
- Oversee and monitor the effectiveness of the municipality's risk management system, including strategic, operational, financial, fraud, insurance, and emerging risks.
- Evaluate the effectiveness of mitigation strategies and management action plans implemented to address material and significant risks.
- Review the material findings and recommendations by assurance providers on the system of risk management and monitor the implementation of such recommendations.
- Collaborate with the Audit Committee on all matters concerning risks and risk management; and provide timely and useful reports to the Accounting Officer and Audit Committee on the state of risk management, together with recommendations to address any deficiencies identified
- Provide timely and useful reports to the City Manager & Audit and Performance Audit Committee on the state of risk management, together with accompanying recommendations to address any deficiencies identified by the Committee.
- Ensure that Business Continuity and resilience strategies are effectively developed, implemented, tested, and maintained across the municipality.
- Promote ethical conduct, fraud awareness, and a strong risk aware culture throughout the municipality.
- Perform any other duties and responsibilities as set out in the Risk Management Committee Charter and applicable legislative and governance frameworks.

TERM OF OFFICE

The term of office for the appointed member will be three (03) years.

REMUNERATION

Chairperson who is appointed will be remunerated for attending meetings in accordance with National Treasury guidelines or at the amount determined by the City Manager.

The successful candidate will be required to sign a contract with the Municipality. The appointed candidate will be subjected to a security vetting and screening process.
