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WATER SUPPLY INTERRUPTION DUE TO MAJOR PIPE BURST AT OLIFANTSPOORT PLANT

Polokwane Municipality received communication from Lepelle Northern Water (LNW) at 02:52 this morning, advising that the Olifantspoort Water Treatment Plant is currently offline due to a major burst on an 800mm pipeline.

The bulk water supplier has indicated that the incident requires a cut-and-replace intervention to facilitate the necessary repairs.

At this stage, Lepelle Northern Water has not yet provided timelines for the completion of repairs and the restoration of water supply.

The interruption is expected to affect water supply to the following areas:

- Ga-Chuene
- Thokgwaneng
- Polokwane City
- Seshego

Polokwane Municipality is engaging with Lepelle Northern Water to obtain regular updates on the progress of repairs and the anticipated restoration of water supply. Further communication will be issued as soon as information becomes available.

Residents are urged to use available water sparingly and to make the necessary arrangements to manage their water needs during this period.
