POLOKWANE MUNICIPALITY APOLOGISES FOR TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES

Polokwane Municipality sincerely apologises to residents, motorists, businesses and all road users for the inconvenience caused by temporary road closures across Polokwane, Seshego and Mankweng.

These closures are necessary to facilitate one of the municipality's largest road rehabilitation and expansion programmes aimed at improving road safety, reducing traffic congestion and providing durable infrastructure for the future.

MANKWENG

The municipality is upgrading the road linking R71/Paledi Mall, Mankweng Hospital and the University of Limpopo into a modern four-lane carriageway to improve traffic flow and accommodate growing transport demand.

The following streets in the City and Seshego are under rehabilitation:

POLOKWANE CENTRAL

- Dorp, Burger, Voortrekker, Oost, Compensatie, Jorissen and Landdros Mare Streets.

FLORA PARK

- Macdonald, Knox, Jasmyn, Katjepiering and Euphorbia Streets.

NIRVANA

- Jaipur, Monsoon and Istanbul Streets.

WESTENBURG

- Leon, Coverdale, Kelly and Mohamed Streets.

LADANNA

- Veldspaat, Dendron/Witklip, Pietersburg, Emerald, Bulawayo, Railway, Lood, Mika and Fosfaat Streets.

SESHEGO

- Thaba Chueu, River Cross, Alf Makaleng, 68th Avenue, Zone 1 Extension, Solomon Mahlangu, Lefi, Johane, Mateo, Khudu, Marabe, 54th, Roma and 67th Streets.

The municipality urges all road users to obey temporary traffic signs; observe recommended speed limits; use alternative routes where possible and cooperate with traffic officials and construction personnel.
